Seamless Summer Option (SSO) FAQs

❖ What are the meal kit prices?

Meal kits are FREE for ALL children ages 18 and under. Your child does not have to attend the Pembroke Pines Charter Schools in order to get free meals.

❖ What are the meal pickup times?

The meal pick up times for distance learners and children in the community are:

- *Tuesdays 10 AM to 12 PM and 3:30 PM to 5:30 PM* (you will receive the meals for Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday)
-And-
- *Thursdays 10 AM to 12 PM and 3:30 PM to 5:30 PM* (you will receive the meals for Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Monday)

In person learners will receive their meals at school during their designated breakfast and lunch times.

❖ Where can you pick up meals?

Distance learners and children in the community can pick up their meals at one of the two locations listed below:

- *East Campus* - 10801 Pembroke Road Pembroke Pines, FL 33025. The drive through is at the same location as the parent drop off route.
-Or-
- *Academic Village* - 17189 Sheridan Street Pembroke Pines, FL 33331. Meals will be available through the Sheridan St. entrance past the football field next to the concession stand.

❖ Do you have to pick up meals every day?

Distance learners and children in the community will come to pick up meals twice a week (on Tuesdays and Thursdays) at time and location that you registered for. On Tuesdays, you will be



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given a prepackaged three day meal kit, which will contain the meals for the Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of that week. On Thursdays, you will receive a four day meal kit, which will contain the meals for the Friday, Saturday, and Sunday of that week, as well as the meals for the Monday of the following week. The prepackaged meal kit will contain one breakfast meal and one lunch meal for each of the days associated with the meal kit and will be accompanied with a menu. The meals will be a combination of cold items and items that will need to be heated (i.e. pancakes or chicken nuggets), which will come along with heating instructions. You will also be offered other pre-portioned items (milk or additional fruit/vegetables) that you can select from.

In person learners will consume their meals for Monday – Friday at school during their designated breakfast and lunch times and will be given their meals for Saturday and Sunday at school to be taken home.

❖ **What is the process of getting the meals?**

Complete the meal registration form (pinescharter.net> Families & Communities> Food Services Department> click the link that says [SSO Registration Form for Free Meals for All Children 18 Years Old and Under](#). Alternatively, you can access the SSO Registration Form by clicking the link below. The parent or child will drive through or walk up to the pickup line. The cashier will verify that the child is age 18 or under, give the parent or student the meal kit. For parent pickups where the child is not present, the parent must display a form of child identification such as a birth certificate; identification badge; report card; class schedule; registration; passport, adoption decree; doctor, clinic, or hospital record; religious record; daycare center record; etc.; to the cashier.
